Circle of Care: The Ma Mawi Wi Chi Itata Centre is seeking individuals for casual Youth Mentor positions. The successful candidate will be responsible to facilitate and support at-risk females 14-17 years of age in care with various Child and Family Services agencies. The site is a 10-bed facility that will operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and offer a wide range of assessment and support services. It is anticipated that all beds would run at a high rate of occupancy with a 30-45 day maximum residency.

Honoring the Spirit of Our Little Sister's: The successful candidate will be responsible to facilitate and support at risk females 12-16 years of age. The site is a six-bed facility that will operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and offer a range of assessment and support services.

Four Fires: Four Fires strives to provide a nurturing and safe environment for young male's ages 11-14 years old. The site is a six- bed facility that operates 24 hours 7days a week and offers a range of assessment and support services. The Young Warriors Lodge is a safe and nurturing environment where the young men will have the opportunity to experience a strong sense of caring, support and encouragement while building the capacity to achieve their goals and dreams.

Isobel's Place: The Ma Mawi Wi Chi Itata Centre is currently seeking an individual for the position of casual Youth Mentor. Isobel's Place strives to provide a nurturing and safe environment for pregnant and adolescent parents to acquire skills necessary to make informed decisions and healthy choices for themselves and their children. Programming is designed to build on the capacities of children, parent, family and community through providing interactive learning experiences. Isobel's Place is a residential care facility that operates 24 hours, seven days per week.
